Lección 4: -AR Conjugation

*Know the Spanish subject pronouns.

A. The subject pronouns are:

Singular		Plural	
yo	(I)	nosotros	(we, masculine)
		nosotras	(we, feminine)
tú	(you, familiar)	vosotros	(you, plural, masculine)
		vosotras	(you, plural, feminine)
			*Spain only
él	(he)	ellos	(they, masculine)
ella	(she)	ellas	(they, feminine)
usted	(you, formal)	ustedes	(you, plural)

*Know how to conjugate regular -ar verbs.

B. In order to have a correct verb with each subject, the infinitive of the verb is changed so that the verb form agrees with the subject pronoun or noun. Drop the ending **-ar** and add the endings that belong to the different subjects. This step is called **CONJUGATION**.

Example: mirar (to look)

If the subject pronoun is yo	add o	to the stem: yo miro
tú	as	tú miras
él	a	él mira
ella	a	ella mira
usted	a	usted mira
nosotros	amos	nosotros miramos
nosotras	amos	nosotras miramos
vosotros	áis	vosotros miráis
vosotras	áis	vosotras miráis
ellos	an	ellos miran
ellas	an	ellas miran
